Communication

School Dinners

It is a parent/ carer's responsibility to order a school lunch via ParentPay before the school day starts.

If you do not order your child's lunch we do not know what you want them to have. Please do NOT order a jacket potato unless they plan on eating it as these are cooked to order.

Packed Lunch

To maximise healthy life habits and learning ability, we encourage children to bring in a healthy and balanced packed lunch. Please do not give your child more than one small sugary snack.

Morning snack

Fruit is provided for all children who want it in the morning so there is no need to send in a snack. If your child does not like fruit, please send in a healthy alternative such as crackers – PLEASE no sweets or bars of chocolate!

Uniform

It is lovely to see nearly all pupils coming to school in our school colours and uniform. Please remember that we have plenty of spare uniform we can give you.

Please remind your children that no jewellery is allowed other than a non-smart watch or studs/ small hoops. This is for health and safety and to ensure nothing of value is lost.

School Times

Breakfast Club starts at 8.15am. Please sign a permission form if you want this provision.

Children need to be supervised while they wait for Breakfast Club to open.

Breakfast Club doors close at 8.30am.

By 8.55am: Pupils should arrive at the back of the school and line up on the playground next to the school.

3.30pm: Pupils should be collected from the back of the school. Y5/6 children may walk home without their parent/ carer with permission.

Remember that insisting on good school attendance is one of the most important gifts you can give your child.
