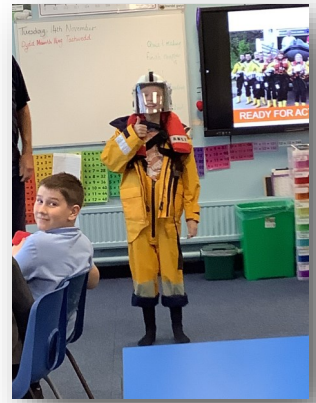




# PPS News
